





How to reset your PowerSchool Password

1. Go to https://powerschool.wasd.org/public/

(Do not use the Student Portal App)


- a. You can go to WASD Dashboard and click the PowerSchool Student Icon.
- b. Remember, use a web browser and not the student portal app.
- 2. A sign in box will appear on your browser click "Forgot Username or Password"






How to reset your PowerSchool Password

3. Enter your PowerSchool Username (5-digit code) (Example JBKCD) & your WASD e-mail address. WASD has access to your PowerSchool Portal username but not your password. If you forget your username, contact the school.




How to reset your PowerSchool Password

- Go to your WASD Outlook e-mail through your WASD Dashboard.
- 5. Find the e-mail from "WASD PowerSchool" and click the link.



- 6. Follow the directions to reset your password. Once your password is reset you can open the app on your phone Login with your username and new password.



BANK Period:


- Held Tuesday/Thursday Period 5










Cell Phone Information
