INTRODUCTION

Williamsport Area High School will offer two forms of summer courses (credit acceleration and credit recovery) to all high school students. Acceleration courses are available for incoming 9th grade students. Summer school courses are available both in the classroom setting and online. Students who successfully complete their course will receive full credit for the class. Registration materials are available online and in the counseling offices of all area secondary schools.

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ON-CAMPUS SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE OFFERINGS

ON-CAMPUS COURSES – 1/2 CREDIT (3 WEEK DURATION)

These courses available for either **ACCELERATION** or **CREDIT RECOVERY**

PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

This course is offered to students who want to get ahead in their graduation requirement and make room in their schedule for other electives. Students who need to make up a Physical Education credit may also elect this course. *MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT – 25 students*

Students must be able to participate in physical activities (to include swimming).

- 8:00 – 1:00pm (June 11-14) then 8:00am – 12:00pm (June 17-28)
- Mandatory attendance requirement

CAREER PATHWAYS/FINANCIAL LITERACY:

Offered primarily to incoming 9th grade students who want to get ahead in their graduation requirement and make room in their schedule for other electives. *This is a 9th grade required course.*

- June 11 – June 28
- Monday – Friday (First day of classes is a Tuesday)
- 8:00 – 1:00pm (June 11-14) then 8:00am – 12:00pm (June 17-28)
- Mandatory attendance requirement

HEALTH 01:

Offered primarily to incoming 9th grade students who want to get ahead in their graduation requirement and make room in their schedule for other electives.

- 8:00am – 12:00pm
- Mandatory attendance requirement

A mandatory on-campus orientation session will occur on the first day (see orientation section for times). Students will be given their user names and passwords at that time and shown how to access their course. Instructors will explain the course requirements, expectations and establish a schedule for mandatory face-to-face time with credit recovery students for the first week, mid-point and at the end of the course. Minimum face-to-face time with your instructor will be 20 hours or more depending on need.

There is not a mandatory time the student must be online. Lessons and assignments can be completed independently on the internet at any time and from any place. *However, students must stay on track with course timeline, make reasonable progress and have all course work completed by the end of the term (August 3). Final exams will be given face-to-face with the instructor.*

STUDENTS MAY ONLY TAKE ONE ONLINE CLASS AT A TIME.

If the first class is completed within the first half of the summer school session then the student may enroll in a second class at that time. Multiple class enrollments will not be accepted at the start of summer school.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION – DEADLINE: JUNE 6TH

Registration forms are available in the counseling offices of all Lycoming County secondary schools as well as on the Williamsport Area High School (WAHS) website <http://www.wasd.org/summerschool>.

After students have met with their counselor and have made course selections, registration can be completed for students at the Williamsport High School in the main office or online.

Online registration can be completed on the WAHS website <http://www.wasd.org/summerschool> and payment may be made through the District's **School Cafe** payment portal: <https://www.schoolcafe.com/initial> with a valid Visa or MasterCard. **A 5% convenience fee applies.** This is the same portal that parents use to add funds to their children's lunch accounts. Parents desiring to pay online may do so by using the same username and password previously set up for this purpose but select "Summer School" as your payment direction. *This service is available to WASD students ONLY.*

Payment for walk-in registrations can only be made with cash or check made payable to "WASD".

DEADLINES: *REGISTRATION CLOSES THURSDAY, JUNE 6, 2019.*

LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ADMINSTRATIVELY APPROVED.

ACADEMIC REFUND POLICY

Students may receive a 100% refund if they withdraw from a course before the first day of class (orientation).

Students may request a partial refund after the start of the term for extenuating circumstances only. A school administrator must approve all refunds which will be subject to a review of initial payment.

COURSE TIMES AND ORIENTATION

****NEW THIS YEAR**** – DELAYED OPENING AND LONGER HOURS

Classes will begin this year on Tuesday, June 11. During the first week (June 11 - June 14) students will attend from 8am – 1pm then the hours will change to 8am – 12pm for the rest of the term (June 17 – June 28).

MANDATORY ORIENTATIONS

Orientation sessions are mandatory and essential for both hybrid online and on-campus students.

Instructors will demonstrate to each online student how to access their course and explain their expectations and testing requirements. On-campus students' orientation will be their first full day of summer school.

Orientation for all classes will occur on the first day of summer school (Tuesday, June 11) with the exception of Health 01 (July 8). Hybrid online class orientations will occur in the High School Library unless otherwise stated. Find your class and orientation time below.
