# Williamsport Area High School Summer School 2022

#### **INTRODUCTION-**STUDENTS MAY ONLY ENROLL IN ONE FULL CREDIT

Summer school is an academic enrichment program for students who desire additional learning opportunities. Time is precious; each day is equivalent to a week of study during the regular school year.

From June 13 – August 5, Williamsport Area High School will offer one form of summer courses - credit acceleration - to WASD enrolled high school students and incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students (acceleration courses only). Students may only enroll in one summer school class during the summer term. **Non-resident registrations will not be accepted this year.** 

All summer school courses are being offered remotely in the Schoology virtual learning system. Students will attend daily live lessons 5 days a week (Monday – Friday) and should expect to work 2-3 hours per day. Course credit is earned with a grade of 65 or higher. Students who do not complete the course will not receive course credit and will have the failing grade transcribed on their high school transcript (affecting rank and GPA).

Registration materials are available online and in the WAMS and WAHS counseling offices.

#### **NO SUMMER SCHOOL FEES**

Williamsport Area High School will offer, free of charge, one form of summer courses. Credit acceleration courses are available to WASD high school students. Acceleration courses are available to rising 9<sup>th</sup> grade students as asterisked.

All summer school courses are being offered remotely in the Schoology virtual learning system. Course credit is earned with a grade of 65 or higher. Students who do not complete the course will not receive course credit and will have the failing grade transcribed on their high school transcript (affecting rank and GPA).

A <u>mandatory</u> orientation via a live Zoom meeting will occur for all courses on the first day - 6/13 (7/11 for Health 01) with your instructor (Meeting time will be at the discretion of the instructor). Instructors will explain the course requirements and expectations. Students will be given their course syllabus and shown how to access their course.

#### **ACCELERATION COURSES:**

Lessons and assignments will be completed through Schoology (mid-terms and final exams may be given face-to-face with the instructor). Students must stay on track with course timeline, make reasonable progress and have all course work completed by the end of the term – August 5, 2022. Students who do not complete the course will not receive course credit and will have the failing grade transcribed on their high school transcript (affecting rank and GPA).
