INTRODUCTION-STUDENTS MAY ONLY ENROLL IN ONE FULL CREDIT

Summer school is an academic enrichment program for students who desire additional learning opportunities. Time is precious; each day is equivalent to a week of study during the regular school year.

From June 12 – August 4, Williamsport Area High School will offer summer courses - credit acceleration - to WASD enrolled high school students and incoming 9th grade students (acceleration courses only). Students may only enroll in one summer school class during the summer term. **Non-resident registrations will be accepted this year.**

All summer school courses are being offered remotely in the Schoology (1/2 credit) and Edgenuity (full credit) virtual learning system. Students should expect to work 2-3 hours per day. Daily zoom class for Schoology (1/2 credit) course and Edgenuity (full credit) office hours will be available to support students. Course credit is earned with a grade of 65 or higher. Students who do not complete the course will not receive course credit and will have the failing grade transcribed on their high school transcript (negatively impacting rank and GPA).

Registration materials are available online and in the WAMS and WAHS counseling offices.

Students must stay on track with course timeline, make reasonable progress and have all course work completed by the end of the term – August 4, 2023. Students who do not complete the course will not receive course credit and will have the failing grade transcribed on their high school transcript (negatively impacting rank and GPA).
