- Parental Job Loss/Loss of Income
- Separated from Family

Services and Supports Eligible to the Student

If you and your family are experiencing any of the challenges listed, your student may qualify for the following supports and services.

Services and Supports

- Right to stay in school of origin
- Referrals for medical, dental or other health services
- Transportation to school
- Assistance with participation in school programs
- Coordination between schools and agencies
- Counseling
- School supplies
- Referral to other programs and services
