# Five Pillars of National Junior Honor Society

#### **Service**

Applicants must volunteer eight hours of time per semester to qualify for NJHS.

### **Leadership**

Applicants must demonstrate participation and leadership in school and outside activities.

## **Scholarship**

Applicants must achieve and maintain honor roll during current school year.

## Character

Applicants must avoid demerits and demonstrate Respect, Responsibility, Trustworthiness, Fairness, and Caring.

#### **Citizenship**

Applicants must understand the importance of the "4 Be's." Involvement with such activities as scouting, community organizations, and school clubs are essential.

## **SEVENTH GRADERS**

- To receive an invitation to join NJHS as a 7<sup>th</sup> grader, a student must have earned Honor Roll for the first two marking periods.
- 2. Invited students must complete an application.
- All 7th graders must re-confirm their membership via the NJHS Contract, in 8th grade, to continue membership.
- 4. All members must maintain Honor Roll status.

## **EIGHTH GRADERS**

- 1. To receive an invitation to join NJHS as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader, a student must have earned Honor Roll for the first two marking periods.
- If Honor Roll was not earned in 7<sup>th</sup> grade, but it is the first two marking periods of 8<sup>th</sup> grade, a student is eligible to be invited for membership.
- 3. Invited 8<sup>th</sup> grade applicants must complete the application.
- 4. All members must maintain Honor Roll status.

## An Overview of the NJHS Membership Criteria by Pillar

#### **Scholarship**

Students must make: Distinguished HR High HR Honor Roll

#### **Service**

Required eight hours of community service (per semester).

## **Leadership (minimum of 4 points)**

Music groups, service clubs, sports and approved outside activities will earn a student points in this category.

## **Character**

No more than two (2) demerits Less than 10% absenteeism Demonstrate the pillars of Character Recommended by two teachers
