

### **Athletics**

- In 2017-18, WAMS had more than 20 clubs to choose from.
- Clubs are a privilege, **NOT** a right. (You must earn it!)
- You must be passing all classes.
- You must be following the 4 Be's (no discipline problems).
- You must be present (No unexcused or excessive absences or late to school/class.)
- There are three types of clubs:
  - 1. Fun clubs (Relax and have a good time Ex: Open Gym)
  - 2. Service clubs (Serve your school and community Ex: Student Council)
  - 3. Performance clubs (Create or make something Ex: WAMS TV Studio)
- It is possible to be in more than 1 club

#### Clubs & Activities

(Fridays during Millionaire Block starting in late September)



- What time does school start?
- 7:45 AM.
- Where do I enter the building?
  - Bus riders/Walkers enter through:
    - 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Cafeteria entrance
    - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade athletic entrance
  - Parent drop offs enter through the athletic entrance (Millionaires)
    - 7<sup>th</sup> Grade walk to Cafeteria
    - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade stay in athletic hallway





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- What should I bring?
  - Backpack, pencils, lunch if you are packing
  - Your teachers will tell you what you need
  - Open mind and positive attitude
- Can I bring my cell phone?
- Yes. However, it must be OFF and IN YOUR LOCKER from 7:45 AM until 2:40 PM.

What should I wear to school?

- Appropriate clothing for school When it comes to clothes, make sure you are *fully covered and appropriate*
- No Flip Flops (Sandals must have straps around the heel)
- Muscle Shirts or Spaghetti Straps (Must be 3 fingers in width)
- No short skirts or short shorts (Must extend past fingertips with arms hanging at your sides)
- No inappropriate or offensive language, pictures, or slogans

- Can I get breakfast on Monday, August 27?
- Yes. Breakfast will be available every morning. It is your choice whether you get breakfast. Breakfast stations are available at both 7<sup>th</sup> grade student entrances.
- Will I eat lunch on Monday, August 27?
- Yes. Lunch is served every day of the school year except the final day (1/2 day on June 5, 2019)

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#### **WASD Weapons Policy #218.1**

- The term "weapon" refers to any item that may inflict serious bodily injury or is a replica of that item.
- Taser, firearm, "BB gun," knife, pepper spray....

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- On school property or during school time (portal to portal).
- "Portal to portal" is the time you leave your home in the AM until you return in the PM.
- Bus stops are considered school time/property.
