- First, please be sure that the application is printed neatly and that it is complete.
- Please be sure that you meet the qualifications of the scholarships that you check off.
- Please be sure that all supportive forms are included with each application.
- Applications are due in the Counseling Office by March 24th, 2023. This deadline will be adhered to strictly! All supporting documents must be included.

Supporting Documents Include:

- 1. Copy of High School Transcript (or college for post-graduates)
- 2. Copy of SAT/ACT scores from College Board or from transcript
- 3. True copies of the parent & the student 1040 Federal tax Forms * You do not need to include supporting documents just the 1040 is required. State returns are not needed.
- 4. Copies of the W-2 Tax Forms for the parent & student. *
- 5. Complete the FAFSA and attach the summary sheet showing your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)

Shirley L. Dieffenbach Scholarship Award	To a senior male or female who displays academic and creative excellence in the Visual Arts who has been accepted into an undergraduate college or university – preferably Kutztown State University – to pursue a degree in Art Education or Fine Arts.

This scholarship shall go to a recipient that is receiving no more than two other awards/scholarships for graduation. The recipient should be a student who has performed well but, in the opinion of the teachers and administration, has unrealized potential for academic excellence.	
Margaret Hamilton Quinn	Awarded to a senior with high scholarship achievement who would find it impossible or at least difficult to secure a college education without financial help. Funds may be used at any college or university. One time award.

May Heilman Spangle Award	To a female student of high scholastic achievement with financial need who is enrolled in an institution of higher learning.	
Louise H. Stryker Award	To a senior planning to pursue a career in music who has shown outstanding music ability, service to musical organizations, and has high scholarly standards.
