

Williamsport Area School District Remote Learning Option

Williamsport Area Middle and High School: Grades 7-12

What is the Remote Learning Option?

Families choosing remote on-line learning can stay connected to WASD by selecting **WASD's Remote Learning** option. This online choice will use WASD's teaching platform, known as Schoology, and be delivered by WASD teachers. Students will work from home or a remote location and will not attend school. Students will receive a Chromebook device to access district curriculum.

- Students participate remotely, online, 5 days a week, all classroom content, assignments, tests, quizzes, and student work will be completed and submitted online
- Planned instruction with new learning will be delivered and grades given based on WASD's grading procedures
- Students taught by WASD teachers
- Students have options of accessing live lessons, recorded lessons, and video lessons
- Students will receive their personal schedule and will be able to view lessons with in-school peers
- Families provide internet access
- Student attendance counts by <u>daily</u> logging in and completing assignments
- Students may access curriculum in real-time during the school day (synchronously) and work flexibly on their own time (asynchronously).

Technology Tools and Learning Platform

- All students, K-12, will be assigned a Chromebook
- All teachers will use the common teaching and learning platform, Schoology
- Parents have real-time access to Schoology through online/mobile app
- 5 days of curriculum delivered, weekly, to keep students prepared

Why participate in WASD's Remote Learning option and not a cyber school?

- Direct and personal connection to a WASD teachers and WASD resources
- Remain in WASD receiving district curriculum same as peers
- Easier transition back to class and courses when ready to return
- Participate in WASD extra-curricular activities and sports (ie. band, chorus, orchestra, all PIAA sports)
- Special education supports and services still in-place
- Flexibility of learning time

- Supportive services from counselors, social workers, special education teachers, speech therapists, and administrators
- Graduate with a Williamsport Area High School Diploma
- Access to comprehensive career and technical education programs
- Advanced placement courses
- Contact with school district principals
- A supportive school system that already knows your family and needs

Families choosing a Remote Learning Option will receive contact from their school the week of August 10 -14, to confirm their participation. We welcome and encourage families to return to school, when comfortable in the Hybrid or In-Person Phase.
