What is Hybrid Learning?

Hybrid learning is a *combination* of in-person and remote online learning. The in-person time happens in class where students have direct access to their teacher. The remote online learning time, with same teacher, can be done at home or other remote location

- Students attend school, in-person for 2 days a week, full days
- Students participate 3 days a week remotely online accessing new learning and completing assignments
- Students will be assigned an A or B Schedule – 50% of students in each group
- Students will be scheduled alphabetically (by last name) to maximize the grouping of same family members, in the same household, together into alike schedules.

Technology Tools and Learning Platform

- All students, K-12, will be assigned a type of Chromebook
- All teachers will use the common teaching and learning platform, Schoology
- Parents have real-time access to Schoology through online/mobile app
- 5 days of curriculum delivered, weekly, to keep students prepared

Hybrid learning lessons contain two parts: in-person learning and remote online learning.

In-Person Learning

2 days per week; teacher faceto-face time, direct instruction, tutorial support, hands-on labs, projects or specific activities that in-person is the preferred delivery. In-person time may also be used for well-being checks and services. Student supports and small group instruction delivered in-person.



Remote Online Learning

3 days per week; students will use remote learning days to access live or recorded lessons, work on new learning, complete class assignments, independent reading and writing assignments. Student supports, services, and small group instruction available remotely.
